- Meet minimum requirements with regard to GPA (3.5 on a 4 point scale) and ACT Composite of 20 with a Math ACT of 20 or equivalent SAT

- List non-school related activities in which you have participated
- List academic honors, civic honors, or awards you have received

### 2. Employment Record

- List all jobs you have held. Include the names of the employer, the dates of employment, and the type of work you performed.

### 3. Essay Question

- The purpose of the scholarships is to encourage and enable students with the ability to pursue a career in the field of engineering. Discuss, in 250 words or less, your goals, plans, experiences and interests in engineering. Essay should be typed, double-spaced, on a single sheet of paper.
